

PRIVACY

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners is committed to protecting the privacy of visitors to this website (the "Site"). This privacy policy explains how we may collect personal data and how we use the information we may collect about you. Cross Atlantic Capital Partners reserves the right to amend this Privacy Policy at any time. Please check back frequently in order to see changes. Your use of the Site constitutes your acceptance of the Privacy Policy, as it may be amended from time to time.

1. Collection of Personal Information from Site Users

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may collect and/or track: (1) the home server domain names, e-mail addresses, type of computer, and type of browser program used by visitors to the Site; (2) the e-mail addresses of visitors who communicate with Cross Atlantic Capital Partners or the Site via e-mail; (3) information knowingly provided by the visitor in online forms, registration forms and surveys, (including name, address, e-mail and other personal profile data); and (4) aggregate and user-specific information regarding page views.

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may place Internet "cookies" on your hard drives. Internet cookies save data about the history and viewing preferences of individual visitors, so that if the visitor revisits the Site, Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may recognize the visitor by the Internet cookie and customize the visitor's experience. Visitors may decide not to accept Internet cookies by using the appropriate feature of their browser, however, this may affect certain features of the Site.

When a visitor performs a search within the Site, Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may record information identifying the visitor and the search performed. Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may also record limited information associated with every search request made by the visitor and use that information for internal purposes.

2. Use of Personal Data Collected

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may use personally identifiable information in a number of ways, such as:

To communicate with you about your account, or to communicate information about the Site.

To provide more useful services, such as by analyzing usage trends, and by measuring user data regarding specific areas of the Site.

To provide you with prompt and effective service.

To support the operation of the Site (such as account maintenance and record keeping), resolve technical problems, resolve disputes, and enforce the Terms and Conditions.

3. Disclosure of Personal Data Collected

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners may disclose personally identifiable information about you to Third Parties as follows:

With your consent we may disclose personally identifiable information to Cross Atlantic Capital Partners' agents and advisors (such as our accountants or attorneys). We only disclose the personal information necessary for them to provide their services to you or to us, and only under strict confidentiality restrictions.

Otherwise, Cross Atlantic Capital Partners will disclose personally identifiable information it believes necessary to: (a) comply with law (including court and government orders, and civil subpoenas); (b) enforce or apply Cross Atlantic Capital Partners' Terms and Conditions and other agreements; or (c) protect the rights, property, or safety of Cross Atlantic Capital Partners, our officers, directors, employees, members, web site users, or others.

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners will also disclose personally identifiable information if you engage or are reasonably suspected of engaging in any illegal or potentially illegal activity. In this regard, we may disclose personal information even without a subpoena, warrant, or other court order, to the extent we feel is necessary to inform and cooperate with law enforcement agencies or other appropriate authorities.

Finally, we may also disclose information in aggregated form, i.e., information about multiple users collectively without identifying any individual user, such as the total number of visitors to a particular section in a given week.

4. Collection of Personal Data from Children

To the extent that Cross Atlantic Capital Partners is able to determine the age of users of the Site, Cross Atlantic Capital Partners will not knowingly (a) collect or post information from individuals under thirteen years of age (“Children” or “Child”) without their parent’s or guardian’s consent, or (b) provide any personally identifying information collected from Children, regardless of its source, to any third party for any purpose whatsoever.

5. Security Measures

Cross Atlantic Capital Partners has implemented numerous security features to prevent the unauthorized release of or access to personal information. In particular, when a visitor provides information through the Site, Cross Atlantic Capital Partners offers the visitor the ability to use a secure server. The secure server encrypts all information a visitor inputs before it is sent to Cross Atlantic Capital Partners, and is also used to store personal information securely.

6. Third Party Web Sites

The Site may contain links to other websites. Unless we explicitly state otherwise, we have no control over these sites and their privacy practices, and this Privacy Policy applies only to information you supply (or that we collect) in connection with use of the Site. You should review third party privacy policies in connection with visiting the Sites.

7. Opt-Out Right

Visitors may opt-out of having their personal information collected by Cross Atlantic Capital Partners, used by Cross Atlantic Capital Partners for secondary purposes, or used by Cross Atlantic Capital Partners to send promotional correspondence to the visitor, by contacting Cross Atlantic Capital Partners via email at the e-mail address below, or via regular mail or telephone at the address and phone number below.

8. Cross Atlantic Capital Partners’ Right to Contact Visitor

9. Access to and Ability to Correct Personal Data

Visitors may modify, correct, change or update personally identifiable information that Cross Atlantic Capital Partners has collected through the Site or may cause their personal record to be removed from Cross Atlantic Capital Partners’ database by contacting Cross Atlantic Capital Partners via regular mail, e-mail, or the telephone number indicated below.
